CIC Conseil advises the Hecquet Group on their sale to the C.A.R. group, of their division of car dealership located in Bayonne

Owned by the Hecquet family since 1967, the eponymous group is composed of car dealerships specialized in the distribution of brands of the German company Volkswagen (Audi, Volkswagen, Seat, Škoda and Lamborghini).

Mainly present in Normandy, the Hecquet group's revenues amount to about €190 M generated by its 12 car dealerships (including one center of second-hand cars).

As it wished to shift the focus of its activities in the North of France, the company decided to sell its 3 car dealerships located in Bayonne (Audi, Volkswagen and Škoda). This division represents sales amounting to €60 M in total.

Created in 1955 then bought by Emmanuel and Séverine Auffret in 2008, the car dealerships group C.A.R. has developed progressively its commercial presence by external growth and the opening of new establishments.

Nowadays, C.A.R. is well-established in the Charente-Maritime region with 7 car dealerships (including 2 second-hand car centers) and recorded revenues of €140 M in 2019.

This acquisition is completely a part of the C.A.R. group development strategy, which aims at developing its geographical footprint in the Western regions of France.
