SPI Énergie is a subsidiary of the German group KSB (specialized in the sector of pumps, valves and related services, with turnover of c.€2.2Bn). SPI Énergie is based in La Ravoire in the Auverge Rhône Alpes region and is specialized in the distribution, maintenance and rental of industrial air treatment equipment: compressors, dryers, vacuum pumps, filters etc.

SPI Énergie boasts 40 employees with recognized expertise, a network of 6 agencies, a portfolio of 1 200 prestigious industrial customers and an exclusive contract with the world leader Atlas Copco, making the company one of the largest player in the Center East region of France. With €10m revenues in 2019, the company benefited from a strong growth during the past few years, making SPI Énergie the largest distributor of Atlas Copco's industrial sector in France.

SPI Énergie is acquired by the Duffau Group, a family-run company based in Talence, near Bordeaux, and benefitting from a 40-year experience in the industrial air business. Duffau is the exclusive distributor of Atlas Copco equipment in the South West region. This acquisition will allow the group to pursue its growth by extending its coverage of France. The new group's turnover will reach c.€25m revenue.
